When Good Gets in the Way of Best

Why does the to-do list never seem to shrink? You work hard all day, yet somehow the pile of “must-do” tasks either stays the same—or worse—grows bigger! In the business world, experts teach a crucial skill: time management. Successful leaders know there’s a difference between tasks that are “nice” to do and tasks that are absolutely essential. The gap between the two can mean the difference between failure and thousands of dollars in profit. That’s why prioritizing what truly matters—and avoiding distractions—is everything.

This isn’t just a business principle. It’s a biblical one.

In Luke 10, Jesus visits the home of two sisters, Mary and Martha. Picture it: the Messiah Himself is sitting in their living room. Mary immediately positions herself at His feet, hanging on every word. Martha, on the other hand, is bustling about, “distracted with much serving” (v. 40). Frustrated, she turns to Jesus and says, “Tell her to help me!” But Jesus gently responds:

“Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about many things. But one thing is needed, and Mary has chosen that good part, which will not be taken away from her.” (vv. 41–42)

“Distracted” means to have your attention pulled away. And doesn’t that describe so much of our daily life? We chase what seems urgent, while what’s truly important—the eternal—gets sidelined. Martha was doing something good, but Mary chose what mattered most.

May the same be said of us: that in a world full of noise and endless tasks, we choose “the good part”—time with Jesus that will never be taken away.

May God bless you this week as you walk with HIM!

The Baptism of Romans 6

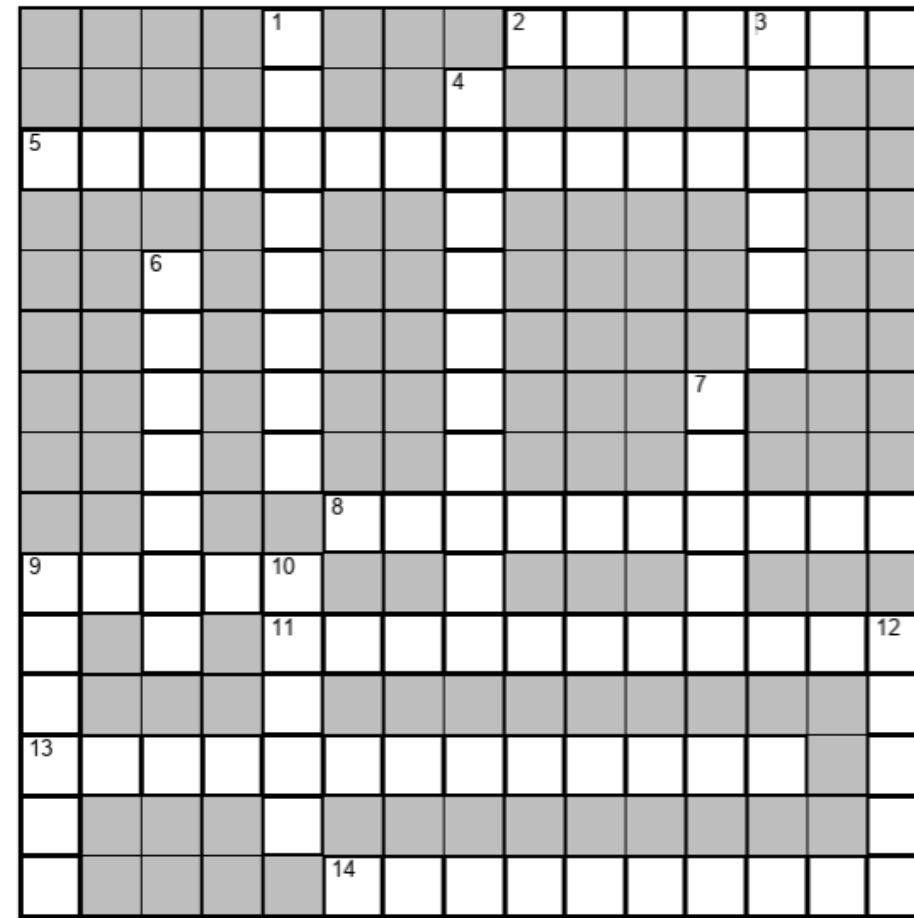
(Romans 6:1-11)
