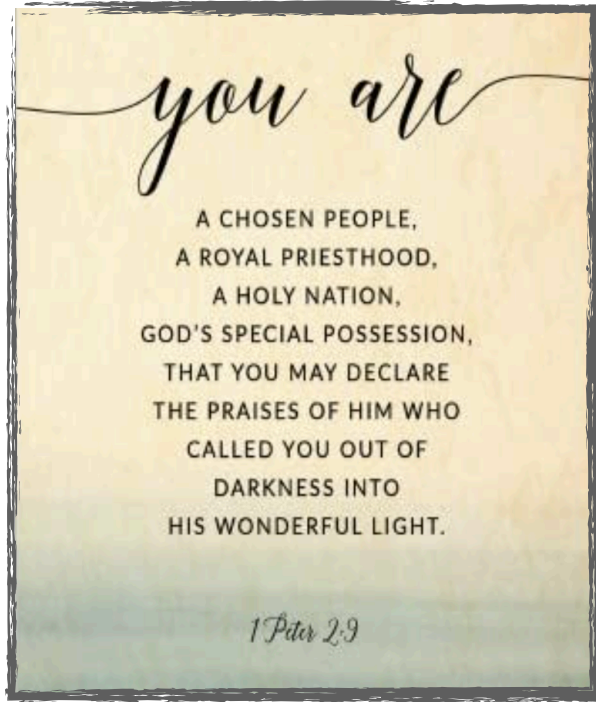

“WHO TOLD YOU THAT YOU WERE NAKED?”



They believed a lie and they ate— Eve then Adam. With that act came the responsibility to discern between good and evil. They immediately were ashamed and sought to hide themselves, even from each other. When God came to the garden, they were hiding. He asked them, “Who told you were naked?” The sin was a burden that ultimately cost them their lives.

The real problem that occurred in the Garden is that it robbed Adam... and God... of the very special relationship they had. It drove a wedge between them... placed distance between them. God asked... WHO DID THIS?

We are still dealing with Satan’s lies that cause a great burden. A survey was once taken on the following question: “What

one thing would you change about your body?” I can imagine the people asked would say: “Just one?” Most of them said that they were “too fat” or “too short” or too something.” Then they asked the same question to children aged 4 to 11. No amount of anxiety or worry will change those things that you were born with. “And who of you by being worried can add a single hour to his life?” (Matt. 6:27). Satan would have us trapped in the prison of our own self-loathing and abasement, not feeling worthy of love and overpowered by a distorted self-image and self-worth.

Listen to what God says you are. “Do you not know that you are a temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?” (1 Cor. 3:16). “Now you are Christ’s body, and individually members of it” (1 Cor. 12:27). “For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus”

(Gal. 3:26). “But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light (1 Pet. 2:9). “You are from God, little children, and have overcome them; because greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world” (1 John 4:4).

We were given this earthly home for just a short time. Do not be burdened with Satan’s lies. It is God that has formed us and God that says who we are. It is God that paid a price so high for us that no one should ever feel worthless.
