GUARDING AGAINST GREED

We need to protect ourselves against continually desiring what we don't have or constantly craving more of what we do.

Be on your guard against every form of greed; for not even when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions.

- **Luke 12:15**

In this passage, the Lord warns us to guard against greed. In other words, we need to protect ourselves against continually desiring what we don't have or constantly craving more of what we do. This compulsion to acquire is dangerous for several reasons:

1. It Breeds Discontent

Continually focusing on what you don't have instead of what you do, creates the feeling of unhappiness within you. What you don't have is never satisfying so focusing on it is always discouraging.

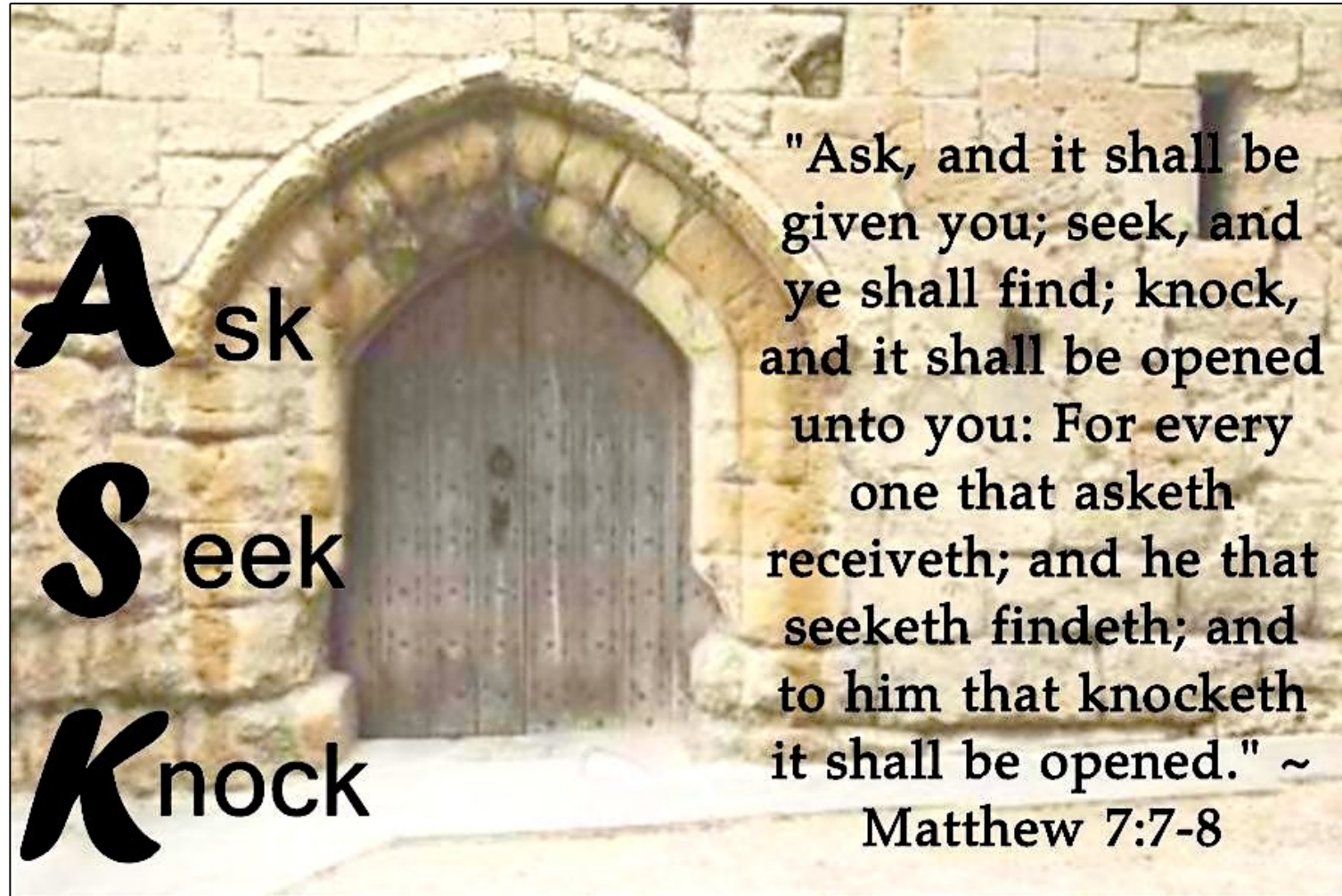
2. It Breeds Covetousness

When your attention is on what others have or can afford, your natural impulse is to possess. Don't look if you can't touch, don't touch if you can't buy.

3. It Breeds Worldliness

Constant attention to material things tends to make us materialistic, especially when our focus is on things that belong to others.

Jesus teaches us that true life, true wealth is not based on what you or your neighbor has. True life is based on what God gives and He gives everything to everyone who asks (**Matthew 7:7-8**). You see, it's easy to focus on what others have or can afford. Guarding against greed requires us to continually ask God to provide for us what we need each day. In this way we will dissolve the constant yearning to possess what's for sale or what others are buying.



"Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened." ~ **Matthew 7:7-8**

THE WORD IN THE WIND

Psalm 19

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit. For the body does not consist of one member but of many. If the foot should say, “Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body,” that would not make it any less a part of the body. And if the ear should say, “Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body,” that would not make it any less a part of the body. If the whole body were an eye, where would be the sense of hearing? If the whole body were an ear, where would be the sense of smell? But as it is, God arranged the members in the body, each one of them, as he chose. If all were a single member, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, yet one body. The eye cannot say to the hand, “I have no need of you,” nor again the head to the feet, “I have no need of you.” On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

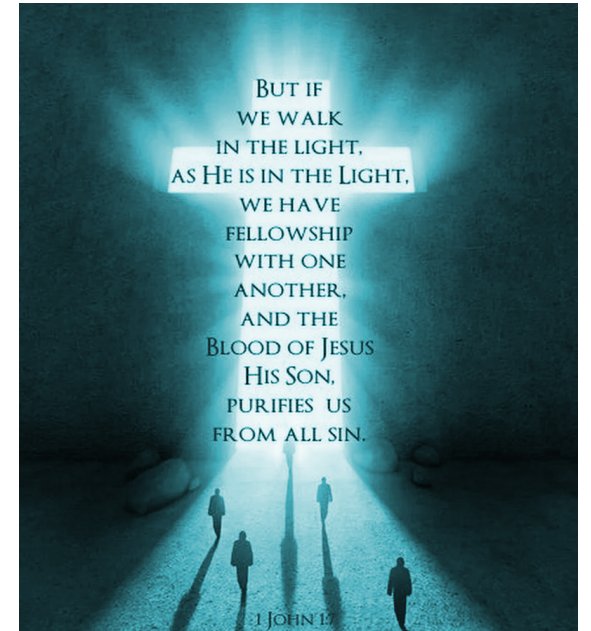

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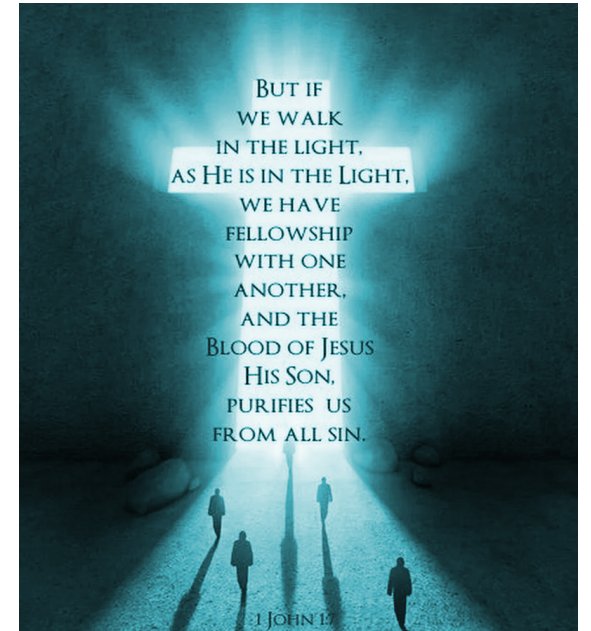
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
