Can You Help Me With A Counseling Problem?

You can be assured that I do not tell others the specifics of any counseling I do as an evangelist, but this particular case has me deeply perplexed and I need some help. If possible I need any input you can give to help me with this problem. It might be easier for you to understand the depth of the problem if I have the situation told to you in the "first person" as if the woman were speaking to you directly. My problem is one that is really bothering me. I have been married for some time. When I was first married I enjoyed being with my husband and honoring him at any time I could. In fact all we could do it seems is to think of one another. But after a while I began to feel that I needed my "own space" and to live my life for me instead of always having to consider him and our marriage in my decisions. Now don't get me wrong, I haven't completely left him - I try to be around him. In fact I am usually with him at least once a week - unless of course something more important comes up. You know what I mean, things like friends coming by, someone else inviting me out, if I'm kind of tired, or something important like that. But he thinks I should be around him more often! I feel so pressured that I am thinking of being around him even less - I really need time for me, time when I don't have to hear about him, think about him, or have to be pressured with his ideas and desires. Oh, I still love him - I just don't think I have to make him the focus of my life anymore. He even has the gall to expect me to think about what I do and make sure it honors his name and our marriage, no matter where I am or when it is! Can you imagine that! I took his name when we married, but he seems to make such a big deal about it! I don't really think it is anyone's business, including his, if I "honor" my husband or not! And if I am around my friends, I don't want them to think he has that much control over my life. I know it is hard for you to understand how I feel - especially since he is so sacrificial in everything he does. He loves me so much



that there is nothing he hasn't or wouldn't give for me. And yes, I realize that everything he does is for my good. In fact, I cannot think of anything he has ever done that even remotely seemed to be selfish, he always wants the best for me. But I just need to think about me and I don't have as much time for Him in my life anymore. Even my closest friends agree that being with him once a week is more than enough time. In fact most of them encourage me to be away from him even more and to think of myself and my needs instead of him. Well, what advice do you think I should give to this bride? Can her marriage make it? What would you say to help her? Perhaps if I tell you who she is it will help you to better see the problem and come up with a solution that will help this marriage be the way it should be - the way it used to be when they were first married...
